The GSA Alliant program provides federal government-wide acquisition platforms to support all IT related requirements and both commercial and noncommercial services with streamlined task order procurements. Alliant 2 and Alliant 3 were designed to overlap in period of performance to allow options and a smooth multi-year transition. Using Alliant vehicles speeds agencies from planning to project implementation, enabling them to concentrate on agency missions rather than acquisition. Alliant 2 and Alliant 3 are Government-Wide Acquisition Contracts (GWAC) available to all US federal civilian and defense agencies. Benefits include:

- Small pools of pre-approved vendors selected for high-quality delivery of complex requirements and use of emerging technologies, including health IT
- Streamlined ordering procedures
- Flexibility in procurement approach and use of ODCs
- Customer agency control of procurement and implementation
