Customers: OASIS is available to all federal government civilian and defense agencies.

Ordering Period: 9/3/2014 - 3/1/2025. Task orders may extend an additional five years.

Ceiling: OASIS does not have a contract ceiling.

Task Order Types: Time & Materials, Fixed Price, and Cost Reimbursable

Pools: OASIS is organized into vendor pools by the primary National America Industry Classification System (NAICS) code. The multidisciplinary scope of OASIS is the same across all pools. The selected NAICS code for each task order determines the appropriate pool of vendors. ICF holds Pools 1 through 4:

Pool 1—Consulting, Engineering, Program Management, Scientific, Environmental, Logistics, Human Resources, Marketing, and Other Services.
